Monogram panel blocks because the panel may be less than 24" wide. Next Step Course the main pattern instructions for cutting Stars, Borders and Binding and Steps 13 to 31 for Star Blocks, Borders and Layer, Quilt, Bind, Label construction.



Background—(PB)	Sashing	1—12" strip x WOF 1—16½" strip x WOF
	Outside Border	DO NOT CUT UNTIL STEP 3.
Fabric C —	Cornerstones	DO NOT CUT UNTIL STEP 6.

Procedure:

MONOGRAM PANEL: This pattern was created for Northcott's Monogram panel. We have discovered that the Monogram panel may be less than 24" wide. The following Steps explain how to construct the large blocks with the four letters and the outside border with the single letters.

WOF = width of fabric



- . **Monogram Panel**—Block and press panel so that corners are 90° and panel is rectangular.
- 2. Referring to the diagram on the left, carefully cut the panel into Six, as large as possible, rectangular or square blocks all the same size. **NOTE**: Length (L) and width (W) should be as close to 12" maximum as possible. The ¼" seam allowance is included in measurement. Large block size _____ L x ____ W

 Then cut the bottom row, letters Y Z A E, all the same square size including ¼" seam


allowance.

Small square size _____ (outside border cornerstone)

3. **Outside Border**: Cut [7] Background **PB** strips the width of Step 2 Small square size x WOF.



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5. From the 12" **PB** strip, cut [10] Step 4 **X Total** ____x Step 2 Large block size **W** ____ rectangles. Then from the 16½" strip, cut [2] Step 4 **X Total** ____x 16½" rectangles. Place along the sides of large blocks.



6. Cut [1] Fabric C strip Step 4 X Total _____ wide.

- 7. Calculate **Z Total** in Step 4.
- From the 16½" PB strip, cut [4] Step 4 Z Total x 16½" rectangles. Then from the remaining 12" and 16½" PB strip, cut [8] Step 4 Z Total x Step 2 Large block size L rectangles. If need be cut [1] Z total wide strip to cut remaining rectangles.
- 9. From remaining **PB** strips cut [2] **X Total** ____x **Z Total** units.
- Sub-cut Step 6 Fabric C strip into [10] Z Total _____ units.



- Place Step 8, 9 and 10 rectangles along the top and bottom of large blocks. Sew all rectangles to blocks. Press to PB rectangles. Should be 16½" square.
- 12. GO TO STEP 13 STAR BLOCKS in main pattern to complete the quilt..
