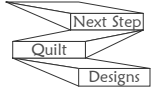
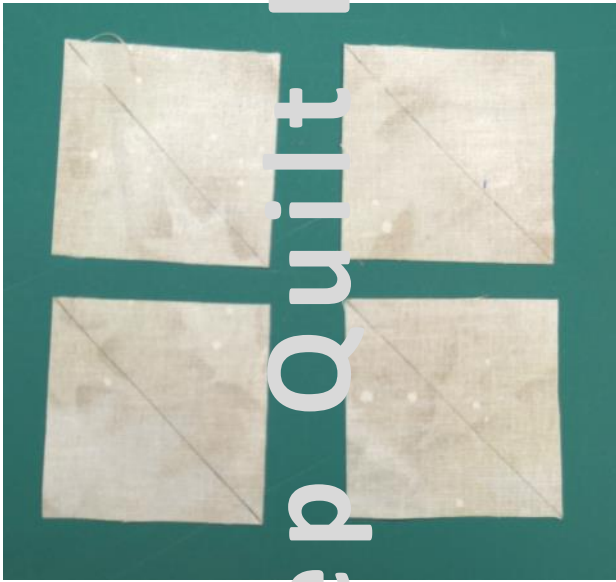




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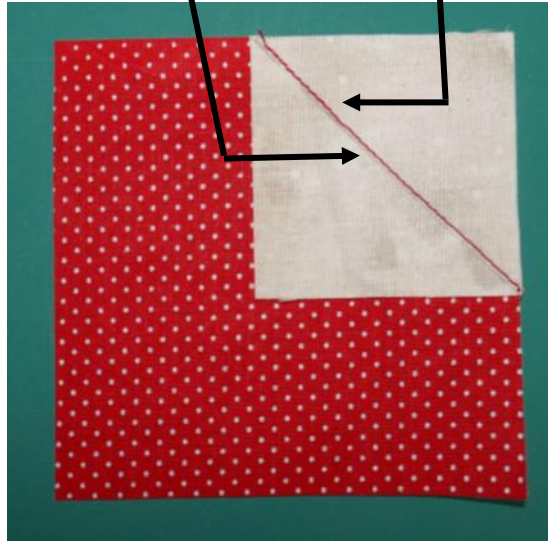
One large square.  
Four smaller squares



Draw a line diagonally on back of the four squares corner to corner.



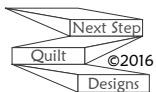
Place smaller square in one corner matching outside edges with the diagonal line across the corner.



Sew along the drawn line on the outside corner side.

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Press to corner

Check that square is still the size of the original square. If larger trim, if smaller resew the seam.



Trim off corner leaving a 1/4" seam allowance



Repeat to all corners





Final corner  
Match corner  
Sew seam  
Press to corner



Trim off corner leaving a  
1/4" seam allowance



Should be same size as  
the original red square.
